

Burnsall along the River Wharfe

Route type: For All. A short linear walk along the River Wharfe – OS Explorer Map OL2

Distance: 0.7km (each way)

Start point: SE032611

Turning point: SE031617

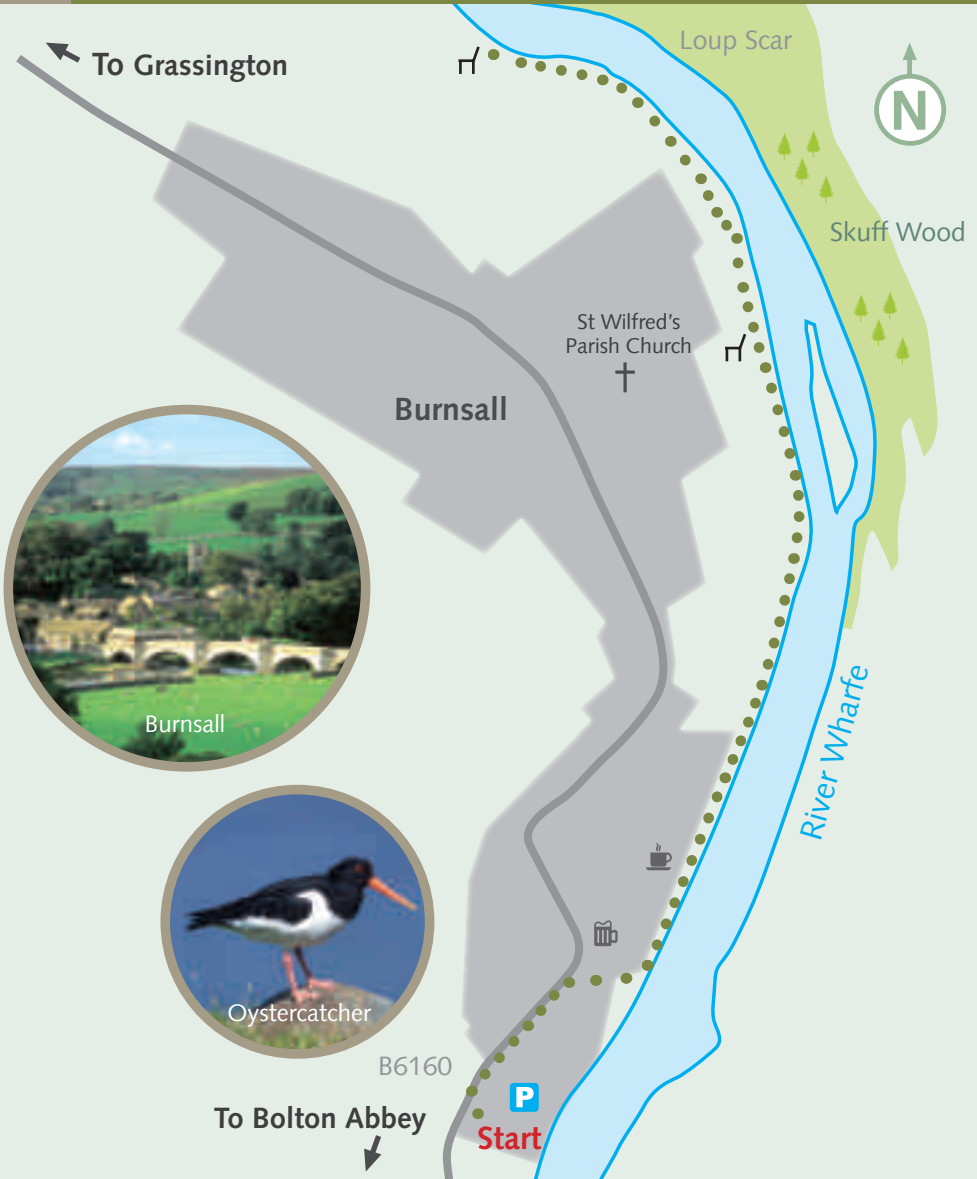
Facilities: The nearest public toilets, including RADAR facility toilets, are in the Grassington National Park car park. Burnsall has a private car park with parking fee.

Getting there: Car: From Skipton take the B6265 towards Grassington. Turn right after Swindon Quarry towards Linton and then right at the T-junction on the B6160 to Burnsall.

The Route

A 700m length of a popular section of the Dales Way runs between the village of Burnsall and Loup Scar. The route is well surfaced and level. There are two kissing gates along its length which can be difficult for scooters.

Whilst walking along the river, look out for pied and grey wagtail, dipper, common sandpiper and oystercatcher.
